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SMA CONNECTOR WARNING



The precision microwave SMA port is easily damaged!

- Do not overtighten brass SMA connectors! The recommended working torque is only **3-5 in-lbs.** Many SMA wrenches are calibrated to 8 in-lbs. for stainless steel connectors.
- If you reconnect to the SMA port frequently, we recommend a port-saver. This pass-through adapter will prevent damage from bad cables and excessive mating cycles. (PN 2081888-1 or similar)
- Do not allow the cable to rotate while tightening it to an SMA connector! Hold the cable firmly while only rotating the threaded collar.
- Be mindful of ESD when handling the SMA port, microwave outputs are not static discharge protected!



Low-quality or damaged SMA cables can destroy the microwave output port!
